Given responses to the special College Council meeting on March 27, Sonya has cancelled the meeting. Agenda items will be moved to our standing meeting on April 17; however, we need to submit the Mission statement for Board approval. I will submit the revision to Board Docs on April 1 so it can be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval at the May meeting.

As you recall, the college engaged in a thorough review and vetting process of the college Mission Statement in spring 2014. The proposed revision below includes a minor revision to acknowledge the Bachelor of Applied Science degree that will be offered in fall 2015. This revision was presented to College Council for a first reading on March 20 and was approved by the Academic Senate on March 25.
